Reporting to the Senior Manager the Family Centre Manager will

- Provide leadership and guidance to our centre teams
- Influence, and help implement, organisational strategy
- Manage therapeutic supports offered to children and families attending the centre
- Manage organisational projects
- Monitor and report on Outcome Measures for the centre
- Ensure operational best practice is achieved by our services for the benefit of children and families attending our centres.
- Provide supervision to the professional staff team

Candidates must have at least five years' experience in a similar management role. A management qualification will give a distinct advantage.

Candidates and must have significant experience networking and influencing change within the voluntary/community sector.

Candidates must have experience using mechanisms to successfully evaluate the outcome of work. Qualifications and experience in the provision of therapeutic supports to children and families is essential.

A full knowledge of the relevant legislation and national policy underpinning work in this area is essential.
